This application must be completed in full before returning it to Programmes and Assessment (Exams & Progress). Once the form is fully completed it should be scanned and returned to OverseasExams@leeds.ac.uk, together with an official letter from your home university to confirm that your term dates at your home university prevent you from sitting exams in Leeds.

The application must be submitted by the end of week 5 of teaching.

You will be charged a standard £50.00 administration fee by The University of Leeds to take your exams at your home institution, which will be added to your account. Please be aware that you will also be responsible for meeting any administration charges your home university may set.
