If you are studying in any of the following languages, or if you are studying in English in a country where this language is spoken, then the Erasmus+ Online Linguistic Support (OLS) is for you!

Assessment element - is it compulsory?

If you are not studying in English, but in **German, Spanish, French, Italian, Dutch or Portuguese**, then the OLS assessment is a compulsory part of your study abroad year and you will be automatically enrolled to the system. You will receive an email to your Leeds student email address inviting you to take the first Online Linguistic Assessment (OLA) a few months prior to the start of your study placement.

If you are **studying in English**, but one of the above languages is an official language of the country you are in, then the assessment is an optional tool for you to improve your language level.

The assessment consists of a simple diagnostic test which will let you know your level. After the assessment you will be issued a course licence to access the online material while you are overseas. You are required to take a second assessment at the end if you took the first, however this is for your benefit to let you know how you've improved and will not affect whether you pass the year.

Optional Language Course

If you wish to take the course and the assessment isn't compulsory then you first need to take the assessment, even if you have no prior knowledge of the language. Email the Study Abroad Office at ErasmusDocumentation@leeds.ac.uk to request an invite to take the first test and get started!
