10:00 – 11:30	Leeds Urban Geology: self-guided Individual walking trail (Please note that this activity is for BSc Geography and Geology students only) What geological observations can we make by looking at the stones used to construct the built environment in Leeds? This self-guided walk introduces you to some of the interesting geological features that can be seen in the city's buildings and statues and includes some questions designed to help you start thinking like a geologist! Beginning at the train station, the trail will lead you through the city centre to the University campus, ending at the School of Earth and Environment.
