


Enter University of Leeds, as you will still

Change your course title to the (INT) version if you're going abroad in any year except your final year - i.e. you're coming back to Leeds for another year of study after your abroad year.

Change your course title to the (INT) (inverted) version if you're going abroad in your final year - i.e. the abroad year will be your final year of study and you'll be graduating after this.

If your course already includes a compulsory year abroad (e.g. language courses) you won't need to change your course title.






If you're transferring onto an (INT) (inverted) course and going into year 4 in 22/23, but you are on the final year of a 3 year course in 21/22 (so ticking 'No'), you might find that you can't submit an online application and you will need to complete a paper application (PR1).

If you're on an (INT) (inverted) course, tick 'Yes' if you transferred onto this course last year, or 'No' if you're transferring onto it this year and were on a different course last year.

If you're already on a course with a compulsory year abroad, tick 'Yes' as you will have been on the same course last year.




Tick STUDY ABROAD for all 3 terms.

Do not tick University or college.

If you do this SFE will think you are studying at Leeds.

If you get a message asking you to upload evidence of your study abroad year, you can ignore this. You don't need to send any evidence to SFE and the University will do this in June. Your loan application will still be assessed by SFE.





Have you been accepted onto the Turing Scheme or the Erasmus+ exchange programme? If you have already applied for your loan, but for the 3 year course, or you find that SFE has rolled forward your 3 year course into 22/23, you can update your online application with your new course details.
